Brief course description	The main purpose of the undergraduate course "Pharmacology" is to introduce students to the science of pharmacology. The course provides a description of the principles of pharmacodynamics, pharmacokinetics and different areas of special pharmacology, with emphasis on understanding of drugs' mechanism of action, indications and side effects. In addition, students are being instructed about safe administration practices and drug calculations.
